### WHAT SUSTAINABLE, ECO-FRIENDLY MATERIALS WERE USED IN YOUR DESIGN?

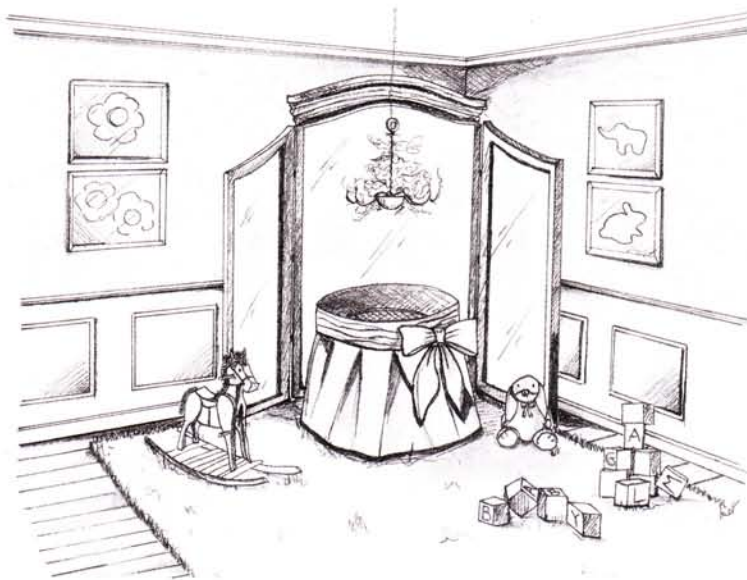
